UT Health East Texas remains committed to expanding access to high-quality care across our region. Our health system now includes eight urgent care locations, with two new sites in Tyler—one on the West Loop and another within our state-of-the-art Three Lakes Parkway facility, which also offers orthopedics and sports medicine, outpatient imaging and advanced cardiac services.

We are also the only health system in the region providing ECMO (Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation) and have invested in a specialized critical care ambulance designed to safely transport both ECMO patients and neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) infants.
